

ARIZONA DEBATE INSTITUTE PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT

I have read this document and the accompanying rules and regulations and agree to adhere to the conditions without reservation. I also understand that violation of the ADI rules, the Arizona State University regulations, or the laws of Arizona and the United States will be considered grounds for dismissal from the workshop without recompense.

1) In the event any check given by me to the ADI is returned for insufficient funds, I agree to pay the face value of the check plus a \$50.00 processing fee. If I do not reimburse the ADI within 30 days of notification, then I will be held liable for all reasonable costs of collection (including, but not limited to attorney fees, collection agencies and court costs).

2) I understand that I am personally liable for the costs of my tuition and lodging at the ADI. In the event my school fails to compensate ADI for my participation, I shall promptly reimburse the workshop.

3) I understand that my tuition covers my lodging accommodations for the nights of July 25 thru August 6th only. Any additional nights or charges (such as phone, meals, movies, etc.) are my personal responsibility and must be paid upon checkout from the host hotel.

4) I agree to leave my lodging accommodations in a reasonably clean and orderly condition. I further agree to be liable for surcharges associated with damages assessed against my room.

ADI RULES

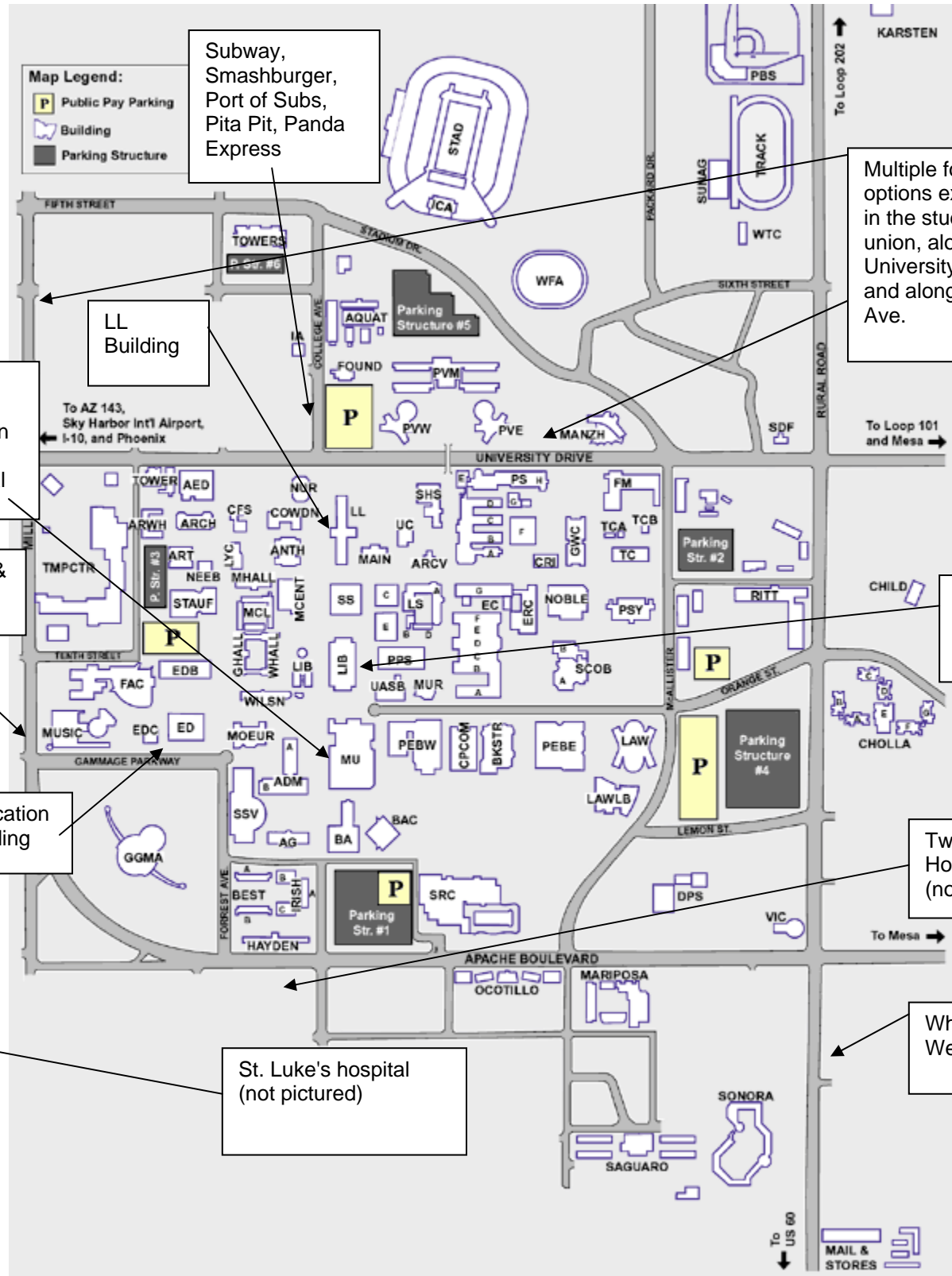
